



A Complete Die, etc., curated by artist Anthony Campuzano, features the work of Kate Abercrombie, John Finneran, Zach Harris, Karen Kilimnik, Anissa Mack, Mark Mahosky, Jessica Mein and Justin Michell. The exhibition will open with a reception on Thursday, June 14 from 6-8pm and will be on view through August 24.

"A Complete Die, etc. brings together the work of eight artists: four men and four women, two from Philadelphia, two from New York, two from Los Angeles and two from exotic places-Central PA and Sao Paulo/Dubai. The center point or vortex or frankly the thing that set me off arranging this exhibition is the dice collection of Justin Michell. It was my desire to see his collection again, in person and in total. In 2009 I was in LA and his collection was just beginning. At that point it filled only a small box or so, and now, in just 3 years, it will fill five large vitrines when displayed in ACD, etc. Responding to the multiple components, fractured surfaces and formal elements of this collection, this exhibition, an 8-sided die, if you will, consists of friends, colleagues and admired artists. Many of the artists are represented by a work that might be read as a detour from their usual practice or a glimpse into a lesser known side of their work.

OK so rules are good in some ways as long as they are able to be bent. In forming this exhibition I wanted to think about symmetry, about color, about collections, about practice, about seriality and about where that "bent thing" happens. Oh and one last thing- I was thinking about where just right and just wrong mean precisely the same thing."
